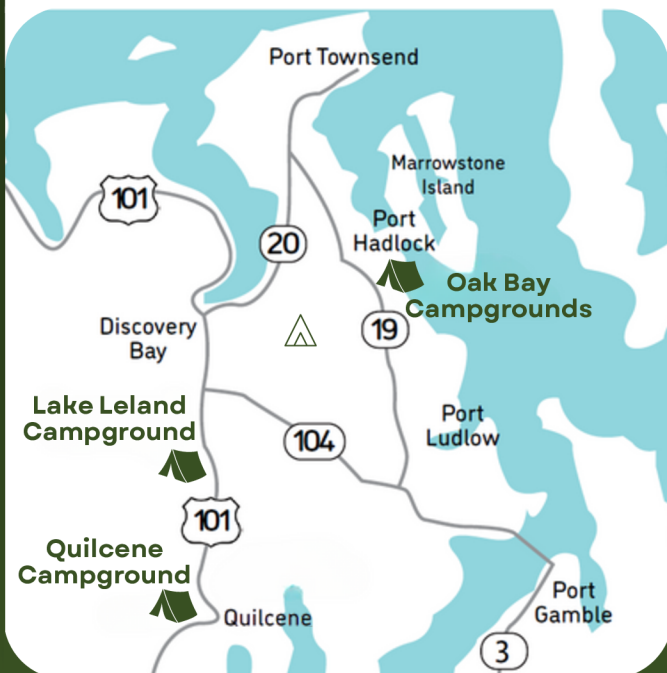

Securing Your Campsite

1. **Occupy a vacant site.**
2. **Use  ParkMobile™ for digital payment**
3. **Post completed ParkMobile card at your campsite.**
 - Checkout is ALWAYS 3pm after last day paid. The app's expiration countdown is not accurate.
 - Staff and Sheriff Deputies have mobile access to ParkMobile payments.

What is a vacant site?

- A vacant site will not have any equipment or a valid tag.

Fire Safety

- Fires are allowed only in designated fire rings.
- Never leave a campfire unattended.
- Douse all fires.
- Use care with cigarettes.
- Fireworks are prohibited.

Laws and Ordinances

- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- No generators or loud voices during quiet hours.
- No amplified music at any time.
- Public use of alcohol or marijuana prohibited.

Use envelopes for cash or check payment. Fill out envelope and flap. Place payment in envelope, tear off flap. Place envelope in metal tube and flap on site post. This option will end after 2025.

What to do if there's a problem

Please call 911 if you experience behavior problems such as noise, intoxication, rowdiness, etc.

We do not have park rangers. The Sheriff is our campground law enforcement. You can also call the 911 operator on their non-emergency line: 360-344-9779.

Remember, don't wait. If you don't call while it is happening, the issue will probably not be resolved.
