Max per site



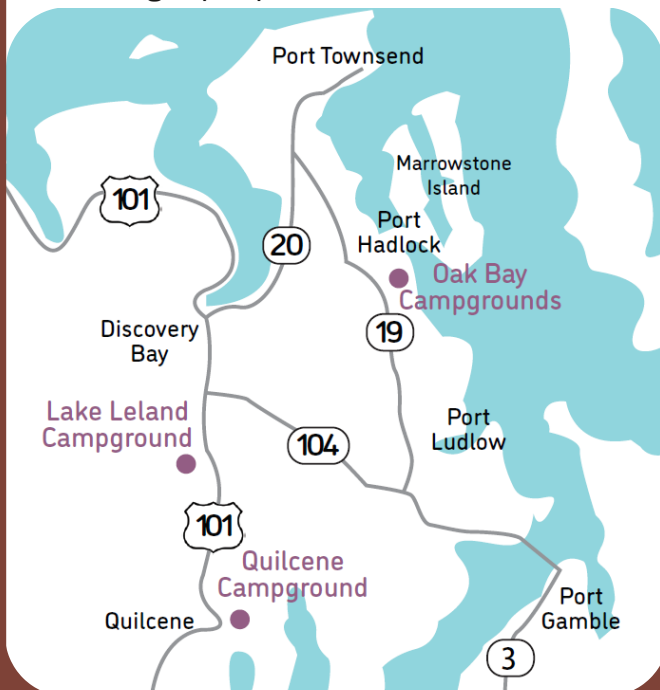
Two tents

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MORE ON THE
OTHER SIDE

All campers must display a complete and valid camping permit at all times. There is no grace period. Campers without a valid permit will be asked to get one or leave immediately.

Payment

Pay at entrance kiosk. Please pay for your entire stay at once.

1. Fill out one payment envelope for each site you'll use.
2. Seal payment in the envelope and detach the top.
3. Drop payment in the metal tube.
4. Clip the envelope top to your campsite post.

Occupancy Limits

- Max per campsite:
8 people; 2 tents; 2 vehicles (trailers count)
- Visitors must use day-use parking at all times.
- 10 night max stay. 3 nights out resets the limit.
- No reservations or site holding.
- All vehicles and gear must fit properly into your site.

Checking out

Check out time is 3 p.m. sharp. Remove your permit when you leave the site.

Fire safety

- Fires are allowed only in designated fire rings.
Never leave a campfire unattended. Douse all fires.
- Use care with cigarettes.
- Fireworks are prohibited.

Laws and ordinances

- Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- No generators or loud voices during quiet hours.
- No amplified music at any time.
- Public use of alcohol or marijuana prohibited.

Assistance

Report all suspicious or illegal behavior to 911 immediately. We partner with Jefferson County Sheriff's Office for campground enforcement.
